I have added less than six, but more than three, key words in alphabetical (ABC) order.
For the selection of keywords, refer to the Medical Subject Headings (MeSH) in PubMed (https://meshb.nlm.nih.gov/search).
References
All the references should be listed in the order of citation in the text. When inserting citation in the text, enter their numbers in the brackets.
I have marked the title of the journal with Index Medicus' acronyms.
I have checked that the format and punctuation of the references follow the contribution rules.
I have written the last name with initials for authors writing in English.
All co-authors should be listed unless there are more than seven authors, in which case the first six are listed, followed by "et al."
Tables
The title of each table is placed in a caption on top of the table and all of this is written in English.
The titles for the tables are brief.
Table footnotes should use these symbols: a, b, c, d, e, f, etc.
The table is self-explanatory and has not duplicated information from the text or pictures.
The outcomes of the table have been reconfirmed and the values are the same as in the text.
Figures
The title of each figure is in a caption at the bottom of the figure and all of this is written in English.
The figures are JPG (JPEG), GIF, and TIFF files (300 dpi or higher).
The explanations for figures (beside the titles) make the figure fully understandable to readers.
